New welder joins Can Man's portfolio



Can Man has launched a new welder in its CM16 series that it says bridges the gap between the CM16-300, which produces 300 cans per minute and the X1 welder, which is capable of producing 600 cans per minute.

Offering the capacity to produce 400 cans per minute, the CM16-400 welder features the same characteristics as the existing CM16-200 and CM16-300 in the

series. They have been developed to provide the ultimate welding quality with reduced power consumption. By using a 'sandwich construction' with the Z-bar mounted between the welding arms, the CM16 results in low inductivity of the secondary welding circuit and this also combines with a reduction in cooling effort.

The CM16 welders are equipped with an easy to handle weld monitoring unit, integrated into the newest generation of digital frequency inverter, the Pacemaker, which ensures that the downtime caused by wire-breaks as a result of over lacquering in the seam area are a thing of the past.

Any faulty cans detected can be counted and rejected as an option.
